ORDER

Now on the 3rd day of January 2024, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, notice having been served upon the licensee to appear and respond to an administrative citation alleging that the license should be suspended, cancelled or revoked as more fully set out herein. In accordance with the Commission’s policies, a proper notice of this hearing was sent by regular U.S. Mail.

The licensee was not present nor represented. The Commission was represented by Ken Yoho, Assistant Attorney General.

Upon consideration of all the evidence in this case, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:

FINDINGS OF FACT:

- 1. That the licensee did, on August 17, 2023, purchase alcoholic liquor from Johnson Brothers of Nebraska and did accept merchandising credit thereupon for a period exceeding thirty days.

CONCLUSION OF LAW:

- 1. That the licensee did, on August 17, 2023, purchase alcoholic liquor from Johnson Brothers of Nebraska and did accept merchandising credit thereupon for a period exceeding thirty days, is in violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-168 and/or 237-LCC6-019.01K and 237-LCC6-018.01A of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
- 2. That the license should be suspended for a period of seven (7) days, with the option to pay a penalty in lieu thereof.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class CK Liquor License of Mark R Florom, DBA – “Topsy Cow”, 709 15th Ave, Franklin, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for a period of seven (7) days, such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 3rd day of March 2024, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 11th day of march 2024, with the option to pay a penalty in lieu thereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$55.00.


