ORDER

Now on the 2nd day of July, 2009, this matter came on for hearing before the Hearing Officer appointed by the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission pursuant to 237-LCC1-002.14 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, notice having been served upon the licensee to appear and respond to an administrative citation alleging that the license be suspended, cancelled, or revoked as more fully set out herein.

In accordance with the Commission's policies, a proper notice of this hearing was sent by U.S. Certified Mail, return receipt requested.

The licensee was not present nor represented. The State was represented by Milissa Johnson-Wiles, Assistant Attorney General.

Upon consideration of all the evidence in this case, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:
FINDINGS OF FACT:

- 1. That the licensee did file a renewal for license after the date prescribed by law.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

- 1. That filing a renewal for license after the date prescribed by law, is in direct violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. §53-135 and/or 237-LCC1-008 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
- 2. That the license should be suspended for a period of three (3) day(s).

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class S Shipper License of Vin Divino Ltd, dba Vin Divino Ltd, 1811 West Bryn Mawr, Chicago IL, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for a period of three (3) day(s), such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 4th day of October, 2009, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 8th day of October, 2009.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the licensee shall pay such costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$23.00. Failure to pay such costs within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order, shall result in further action taken against your license.
