Now on the 23rd day of May, 2007, this matter came on for hearing before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission upon an order to show cause why the license should not be cancelled or revoked regarding the ineligibility to maintain a liquor license due to licensee, Calburt Sheets, being found guilty for deliver/intent to deliver controlled substance, Class III Felony, in violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-125.

In accordance with the Commission's policies, a proper notice of this hearing was sent by U.S. Certified Mail, return receipt requested, and was received and signed for on May 16, 2007.

The licensee was not present nor represented. The Commission was represented by Lynne R. Fritz, Assistant Attorney General.

THE COMMISSION FINDS:

- 1. That the Class III Felony makes said licensee ineligible to hold a license under Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-125.
- 2. That the license should be revoked.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Class IB Liquor License of Lariat Club Inc., dba "Lariat Club", 2200 Proctor Street, Fremont, Nebraska, should be and the same hereby is, revoked, effective at the closing hour of business on the 22nd day of July, 2007.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the license shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$23.00.
